Tower Hamlets Community Governance Review: Phase Two Consultation Why are we writing to you?

In July 2018 Tower Hamlets Council received a valid petition from residents requesting the creation of a new parish council (or 'local council') in the Spitalfields area. The council is obliged to carry out a community governance review under the provisions of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007. The review is considering whether or not a new parish council should be established.

We asked people what they thought about the proposal. You were one of the people who responded to the first stage of our community governance review consultation.

The council has reviewed people's feedback and examined the options and it has now produced draft recommendations as required by law.

There are three options that we want to put to local people for further consultation.

- 1. Create a parish council but with modifications to the proposals made in the original petition. At this stage, this is not the council's preferred option, however if a new parish council were to be created we think it should be called 'Spitalfields & Banglatown Parish Council'. We would also like people's views on possible boundary options.
- 2. Reject the proposal to create a parish council but instead create or strengthen non-parish forms of community governance in the area. At this stage this is the council's recommended option.
- 3. Reject the proposal to create a parish council and retain existing arrangements. This would involve no change, with Tower Hamlets Council remaining the lowest tier of local government in the area. Current arrangements for community involvement and engagement would continue.
