



London Borough of Tower Hamlet Infill Baroness

- Waterproof on all the balconies
- All windows fitted on the North and South elevations, EPDM completion on the East and in progress on the West elevation
- Demise walls and partition walls complete on the 5th floor; demise walls and partition walls in progress on the 4th floor
- Brickwork finished up to 1st floor, blockwork/ risers on every floor
- Pipes installed and tested from the ground floor to the 5th floor
- Temporarily lights and transformers installed on all floors
- EcositeUK Award received
