THH Investigation

- There was a strong disagreement between members of the committee as to whether this should be discussed in Belinda's absence. A lengthy discussion was held.
- It was decided to hold an extraordinary meeting, facilitated by THH at which this can be discussed and Belinda's voice can be heard. Suggested dates 16th or 23 May.
- Meanwhile actions are to return the money to THH (done) review our procedures going forwards.

Waste Management

- LBTH officer nominated to see Mary. He doesn't know anything about the context and new to the area but seems helpful. His day job is recycling happy to deal with all our waste management issues.
- · Walkabout on 22nd April to look at problem areas.
- Prioritise blocks for the walkabout. Schedule that there is someone from each block at each walkabout point. Deal with the priority places.
- Aim for specific actions not general 'isn't the area a tip' comments.
- Kerbside waste pickup bins are permanently stored in the most visual places. Opportunity to have bins permanently located in places that are not visible. We need to highlight the issue of visual appeal issue so that efficiency of emptying is not the only metric.
- If bins were less visible they would attract less rubbish as well.
- Penny counted 10 bins outside Sivill House because they don't have enough frequency of pickup.
- · Post-collection debris issue.
- A lot of blocks have completely different systems so each block needs a different solution
- Gascoigne Place bulk waste is now not working effectively
- Bulk waste not working in general
